THE CHARLES J. "CHUCK" BROWNE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

In addition, copies of the applicant's transcripts showing their grade average and documentation on their volunteer activities they are involved in with the community. A brief written essay on their long-term career goals must also be included. The winners' essay may be posted on our website. Therefore, please submit a hard copy, as well as a CD of the essay response. Applications must be submitted to the Federation office no later than September 22nd, 2023, at 5:00 PM for consideration.*

The Scholarship Fund Committee will carefully review all applications and a decision will be made.

Scholarship will be awarded only one time.

Applicants who are not awarded a scholarship can reapply every school year.
