### ***\*\*Instructions for Completing the Charles J. "Chuck" Browne Memorial Scholarship Application\*\****

#### ***To qualify for this scholarship:***

- Applicants must either be members in good standing or have a parent or grandparent who is a member in good standing.
- A member in good standing is defined as a dues-paying member for at least one year who is current on their dues.

#### ***Applicants must include the following with their application:***

1. A minimum 500-word essay on **"How can Artificial Intelligence support labor unions in growing and retaining membership?"** The essay may include charts, graphs, and attachments. Make sure to include a bibliography of the sources used in preparation for writing the essay.
2. Copies of the applicant's transcripts showing their grade average.
3. Documentation of the applicant's volunteer activities within the community.
4. A brief written essay on the applicant's long-term career goals.

- A hard copy of the essay response.

***\*Deadline:\*\* Applications must be submitted to the Federation office no later than September 25th, 2026, at 5:00 PM for consideration.***

Make sure to include a bibliography of the sources used in preparation for writing the essay. In addition, copies of applicants' transcripts showing their grade average, and documentation on volunteer activities they are involved in with the community. A brief written essay on their long-term career goals must also be included. The winners' essays may be posted on our website. Therefore, please submit a hard copy of the essay response. Applications must be submitted to the Federation office no later than Friday, September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at 5:00 PM for consideration. The Scholarship Fund Committee will carefully review all applications, and a decision will be made.
